

The new wing of our synagogue premises provides an excellent opportunity for dedicating an area for commemorate the lives of your loved ones.

Below are suggestions for donations which will be directed solely for the purpose stated, and with a commemoration plaque or similar.

Location	Description	Amount
Beit Midrash Room	This is the main room of the new wing with a total floor area of about 600 sq. ft. where learning and social activities take place associated with the Beit Midrash.	\$ 50,000
Main Lobby	This is the main entrance hall of the entire center within the new wing with a floor area of about 550 sq. ft. Its wide sliding doors open into the back garden (when the garden is finished), creating a large reception area.	\$ 25,000
Entrance Garden	This is the main entrance plaza leading into the center. Current plans call for an arched gate and covered walkway with garden seating and plantings. The intention is that this will be open to all residents of the neighborhood, creating a welcoming public space.	\$ 25,000
Rear Garden	This will be the main reception plaza outside of the building adjacent to the main lobby. Together with the main lobby, it will be used for high-capacity events such as bar/bat mitzvah parties.	\$ 25,000
Library	We are seeking funding for a full library including shelving for the Beit Midrash. The Masorti community in Safed has donated its library, which is now on temporary shelving, and which needs to be enclosed to preserve its value.	\$ 25,000
Kitchen	This is a spacious kitchen in the new wing with an area of about 250 sq. ft. The community has already invested in countertops and basic equipment but we need additional funds to complete the kitchen.	\$ 18,000
Aron Kodesh	We are planning to install a Holy Ark in the Beit Midrash Room, which would be in addition to the main ark in the synagogue, for use by the Beit Midrash and for children's services.	\$ 18,000
Equipment for youth and children	We need equipment for children and youth both during services and during after-school activities.	\$ 10,000
Light-sound system	The equipment, to be installed in the Beit Midrash room, will enhance study opportunities and enable long-distance interactive communications with our sister communities. The new wing already has the infrastructure ready for Internet communications.	\$ 5,000
Mezzuzot	At the entrances to the synagogue and the Beit Midrash	\$1800 each
Mezzuzot	At the entrances to the kitchen and activity room:	\$1000 each
Seats	Each seat will be dedicated in the name of the donor. Each seat costs \$500; the total cost of seats is \$9000.	\$500 each
Prayer books and Bibles	With a dedication sticker in the interior binding of the book:	\$180 each
